MASON CROFT HISTORIC DISTRICT

COMMUNITY INPUT REQUEST

Dear HSNA Neighbors,

In late 2024, as you may know, the City of Sumter commissioned a Historic Resources Survey, with results presented in late 2025.

The survey indicates that the Mason Croft neighborhood may qualify for potential designation as a historic district—either locally and/or on the National Register of Historic Places (NRHP). Streets that could be included are:

- Crowson Street • Evans Terrace • Frank Clarke Street • Maplewood Drive • Palmer Drive • Stewart Street • W. Calhoun Street • W. Hampton Avenue • Wactor Street • Winn Street.

Important Information

- National Register (NRHP) designation places *no restrictions* on private properties
- The Mason House (111 Mason Croft Drive) is already listed on the NRHP
- If a local historic district is established, exterior improvement plans may need to be reviewed by Sumter's Design Review Board (similar to the Hampton Park Historic District)
